THE SOCCER REFEREE

A watch is a necessary tool to bring to the game. As the Referee maintains the time and has the ability/responsibility to extend the length of the match, he is really the only one who knows how much time is left because he/she is the only one who knows how much time is being added. An Audible Alarm presents two problems. When adding time, players, spectators or coaches can sometimes hear the watch alarm go off and (if they are in the lead) it gives them another reason to complain, particularly if the other team scores during added time. Secondly, an audible alarm can be missed by the referee because he/she is concentrating on the game and there is a lot of noise from players, spectators etc. The "VibraLITE" vibration alarm watch with auto repeat countdown timer has proven a great tool for a referee. Vibrations on your wrist alert you and not others.

The Auto-Repeat Feature on the Countdown Timer on will automatically reset and countdown for the preset time each time it reaches zero. These "interval" reminders are preset once and continue to repeat until you turn the countdown OFF with a push of a button. No need to reset after each period. Selecting a model that has the short one second reminder at 10 minutes and again at 5 minutes before zero is helpful as it is easy to lose track of time when refereeing.

Preset as many alarms as needed for various daily reminders.(ie. meeting times, medications, keeping on schedule etc.) One alarm could be set for your alarm clock time and one or more set for snooze alarms. It's the perfect solution when you have an early wake time and don't want to disturb your sleeping partner or other household members. Preset alarms will be activated and alert you each day. Alarms can be turned OFF easily when not wanted.
